

Torah: The Root of Love and Life

Introduction to a Season

*Now when I passed by thee, and looked upon thee, behold, **thy time was the time of love**; and I spread my skirt over thee, and covered thy nakedness: yea, I swear unto thee, and entered into a covenant with thee, saith the Lord G-D, and thou becamest mine. Ezekiel 16:8*

*Is anything too hard for the LORD? At the time appointed I will return unto thee, **according to the time of life**, and Sarah shall have a son. Genesis 18:14*

*And the woman conceived and bare a son at that season that Elisha had said unto her, **according to the time of life**. 2 Kings 4:17*

We live in a time when supernatural things belong outside of the family of G-d. If I speak to you about patterns, colors, and footprint of evidence some of the imagery in your mind may be like what we have heard from those we understand to be New Age. But what if I told you the New Age system of beliefs stole these things? What if I told you that their G-d is only an imitator and not a creator? He is only a perverter and not the Creator. And yet this is exactly what I am telling you.

I am going to ask you to bravely stay with me and we will explore without flinching some of the things the Creator of heaven and earth, the one true G-d who is the El of Israel, created and gave to us to bring understanding.
