Accommodations:

Lodging will be in Airbnb homes in Tiberias, Jerusalem, the Dead Sea region, and the Galilee. Homes sleep 8+ guests. Rooms are separated by gender. Married couples may not be able to bunk together.

What to Expect:

Hands-on experiences include archaeological site visits, Dead Sea, Masada, Hezekiah's Tunnel, Shabbat meals, Pesach preparation, immersion day, and more. The journey is deeply Scripture-centered and immersive.

Packing Recommendations:

Pack light. Bring 1 week of clothing, backpack, water shoes, modest swimwear, hat, sunscreen, waterproof phone case, and comfortable walking shoes. Laundry facilities are available in some locations.

Recommended items:

- 4 short-sleeve shirts
- 2 long-sleeve shirts
- 6 pants (women may wear dresses or capris)
- 1 jacket (rain jacket recommended)
- 7 pairs undergarments and socks
- 1 modest swimsuit
- 2 towels and washcloths
- Hat, sunglasses, scarf, sunscreen
- 1 pair of sandals, tennis shoes, and water shoes
- Small duffle bag and backpack
- Waterproof phone case
- Electrolytes-single packets such as Liquid IV, Ultima or any other brand

Modesty Requirements:

Women must cover wrists to knees at Western Wall and Temple Mount.

Meals:

Daily Israeli breakfast included. Lunch typically street food. Dinner purchased individually. Shabbat and Pesach meals are shared responsibilities.

Arrival Instructions:

Upon arrival, obtain Israel entry visa at kiosks and pass customs. State accommodation in Airbnb Tiberias.

 - Day 2 (Mon, Mar 23): City of David, Hezekiah's Tunnel, Melchizedek's Temple, Pool of Silwan
 - Day 3 (Tue, Mar 24): Western Wall, Solomonic Archaeological Park, Temple Mount, Old City Shuk
 - Day 4 (Wed, Mar 25): Dead Sea, Barley Field in Re'im, Teaching on Sunset & Erev
 - Day 5 (Thu, Mar 26): Teaching on Boker, Masada, Gilgal, Beit She'an Barley Field, Kinneret Water Show
 - Day 6 (Fri, Mar 27): Capernaum, Shabbat Shopping, Shabbat Prep & Meal, Teaching on Erev
 - Day 7 (Sat, Mar 28): Shabbat Fellowship, Teaching on Bread & Wine
 - Day 8 (Sun, Mar 29): Joshua's Altar (if accessible) or Mount Gerizim, Shiloah, Samaria Winery
 - Day 9 (Mon, Mar 30): Har Megiddo, Mt. Tabor Dig, Nazareth First-Century Church
 - Day 11 (Tue, Mar 31): Galilee Sites: Magdala, Mount of Beatitudes, Bethsaida, Kirsi, Susita
 - Day 12 (Wed, Apr 1): Preparation for Pesach, Twilight Pesach Meal & Teaching
 - Day 13 (Thu, Apr 2): Immersion Day – Baptism in Kinneret or Jordan River, Hamat Gader
 - Day 14 (Fri, Apr 3): Travel Home (depart before noon)
